The final version of a paper must have at least 4 pages and be prepared according to the IEEE guidelines in DOC or DOCX formats (in English only). An extra fee of EUR 20 will be charged for each additional page above 4 pages.

The paper should be submitted using [EasyChair](#) services. The paper template with instructions on submission is available on the Conference Web Page. The paper should define the scope of the paper, emphasize new advances, theories and/or applications and include an analysis of results.

All accepted papers will be published in the IEEE Xplore Digital Library (indexed Scopus, Google Scholar, etc.).

Best of presented papers on the Conference will be recommended in extended article for publication in a special issue of the "[Bavarian Journal of Applied Sciences](#)" and journal "[Advances in Cyber-Physical Systems](#)".

ABOUT CESKE BUDEJOVICE

Ceske Budejovice is the largest city in the South Bohemian Region as well as its political and commercial capital, the seat of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Ceske Budejovice, the University of South Bohemia, and the Academy of Sciences.

It is located in the center of a valley of the Vltava River, at the confluence with the Malse.

Budejovice has long been well known for the beer brewed there since the 13th century. For a time, the town was the imperial brewery for the Holy Roman Emperor, and Budweiser Bier, became, along with Pilsner, one of the best-known lagers.

The old town preserves interesting architecture from the Gothic, Renaissance, Baroque, and 19th century periods.

The Museum of South Bohemia dates to 1877 and holds a large collection of historic books, coins, weapons and other articles.
